Expected Agenda (subject to change!)

- 8:00 a.m. - hearing begins - authors lay out bills; invited testimony; public testimony
- Around 9:15 - hearing recesses for House picture & full House session
- 10:30-12 (or later) - meet at La Quinta (across the street, 300 E 11th St), Lady Bird Room, to discuss the morning on livestream and eat pizza
- After Adjournment (time unknown), the committee reconvenes & testimony continues

Navigating the Capitol

- Park in the Capitol Visitors' Parking Garage (San Jacinto between 12th and 13th). The daily maximum is \$12 - <http://www.tspb.state.tx.us/plan/parking/parking.html>
- If that's full, look for parking meters, especially to the west side of the Capitol
- Entering the Capitol, you will go through metal detectors, but it's not like the airport. Anything that's legal outside the Capitol is also legal inside.
- If you have your LTC, they'll scan your card and let you bypass the metal detectors.
- The elevators are in the North wing. Take an elevator down to **E2**.
- **Hearing is in E2.014**. Kiosks to sign in are behind it. Overflow rooms should be nearby.

Signing in

- Sign in to register your opinion on a bill, or to register to testify.
- You can sign in on the kiosks with iPads in the hallways behind the hearing room.
- You can also sign in on your iPad or other device if you are connected to the Capitol wi-fi. Go to <http://hwrs.house.state.tx.us>. (Note that it is optimized for iPads, but also works on many Android devices, and some phones and laptops.)
- Select the Homeland Security & Public Safety Committee, then HB 375, and your position (we are FOR the bill). Enter your name, contact info, vocation, etc..
